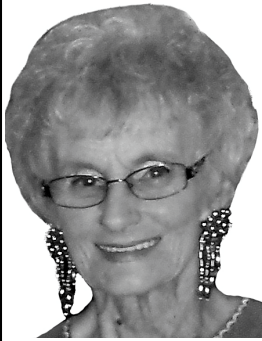


# Happy Holidays
